

**OUTLINE FOR THE EXHIBITIONS TO KICKSTART  
PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN THE PARISH PLAN PROCESS  
(RESIDENTS' SURVEY WORKING GROUP)**

**Dates and venues for Exhibitions (revised 28/9/07)**

Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2007 in Bealings Village Hall, 11am to 4pm.

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> November in Playford Village Hall, 11am to 4pm.

Residents from all three Parishes welcome at all Exhibitions.

Leaflets to announce Exhibitions to be distributed early October.

**Aims of these Exhibitions**

- To raise awareness of the Parish Plan process and get more people involved.
- To identify issues of concern to residents which need discussion/inclusion in our Residents' Survey.
- To recruit people for Focus Groups to discuss and elaborate on emerging issues.
- To recruit further volunteers to help distribute/facilitate/collect questionnaires.

**Proposed Exhibition content**

1. Large Scale Map of each Parish (3 display boards) on which those attending can stick pins to show where they live/their ages, and help them identify locations.
2. Board describing the Parish Plan process and the Timetable of key events.
3. A number of Topic Boards illustrating the main areas which the process could cover, and people to write their own concerns on each board (diff. colour markers per parish).

The Topics suggested so far by the Playford representatives are (with our suggested additions in brackets):

- TRANSPORT (PUBLIC AND PRIVATE)
- ROADS/SAFETY (TRAFFIC/PARKING/CYCLING/WALKING)
- HOUSING/DEVELOPMENT (including AFFORDABILITY)
- SCHOOLS
- SERVICES:e.g.ELECTRIC, (GAS), RECYCLING, FIRE, AMBULANCE
- VILLAGE HALL/EVENTS (AND PUBLICITY)
- FOOTPATHS/BRIDLEWAYS/CYCLE PATHS
- COMMUNICATION
- SECURITY OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY

To this list Great Bealings representatives feel the following should be added:

- NATURAL ENVIRONMENT: e.g. WILDLIFE, TREES, RIVERS, FARMS
- CHURCHES
- ACCESS: e.g. TO JOBS, TRAINING, HEALTHCARE, SHOPS, SPORTS, ENTERTAINMENT, INFORMATION, LIBRARIES ETC..
- ISSUES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE (INC. CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS)
- ISSUES FOR OLDER PEOPLE/THOSE WITH NO CAR/DISABLED
- ENERGY EFFICIENCY/RENEWABLE ENERGY/CLIMATE CHANGE
- POLLUTION: including NOISE, TRAFFIC, LITTER, LIGHT, AIRCRAFT.

To mount this exhibition we have some 7 Display Boards at Bealings Barn (4 uprights and 3 horizontals) providing 14 display surfaces, plus a few more at Annesley – say 20 display surfaces in all. So now we need to finalise topics, layout & design ideas in collaboration with other Working Group members and Vanessa at Garvin Marr Ltd Design Gallery.
